Mr. Henry's House, Inc. is a very structured recovery based environment. We lead clients through a 12-month program with the ultimate goal of finding jobs and permanent housing. Each client is provided counseling and a sponsor to assist with working the 12 Steps of AA/NA. Random drug testing is conducted.

A live-in House Manager monitors each house.

For six months after completion of the program weekly support group meetings and progress reviews are encouraged.

HISTORY

In 1998, a group of recovering drug addicts and concerned community members began discussing the possibility of starting a therapeutic rehabilitation house for people suffering with the disease of addiction.

There was a lack of housing and general support that led to little success of recovery. It is almost impossible to return to a responsible, productive lifestyle without remaining in a recovery treatment atmosphere within the first 3 – 6 months after treatment or after intensive outpatient therapy.

As a result, **Mr. Henry's House, Inc.** was established.

Mr. Henry's House is available to provide the assistance needed for anyone serious about arresting the disease of addiction.

The recovering addict is proof that one may – with the support of a recovery shelter, therapy and adequate management – re-enter society as a responsible and productive member.

Mr. Henry's House, Inc is named in honor of Mr. Henry Mathews who died in 1998 as a result of alcoholism. He will always be remembered for the slogan "You Can Make It If You Try".

PHILOSOPHY

Addiction is a primary, progressive, chronic and terminal disease. Active addiction causes many physical problems and prevents proper treatment and recovery of many health related conditions.

Denial, a principal symptom of the illness, hinders identification.
